COLLEGE YOUNG ADULTS ARE GOING TO ROMANIA IN AUGUST

Currently, we have 12 young people going on this mission trip. (Megan Block, Burke Newman, Troy Soat, Andy Champalath, Dylan Runia, Francine Wiese, Ashton Reiter, Andrea Meyer, Britta Harberts and MaLeaha Doeden). ***We still have two fundraisers going on!!***

1. The first fundraiser we are introducing is an envelope donation.

Taped to the windows in the back of the sanctuary you will find envelopes numbered 1-99. You can take any one of those envelopes and place the dollar amount in the envelope that corresponds to the number on the outside of the envelope. For example, if you take envelope #7 then you would put \$7.00 in it. Please return these envelopes in the box provided. Taking an envelope higher than 50 will receive a free t-shirt.

2. The second fundraiser we are doing is something we call a prayer t-shirt.

You can purchase a Romania t-shirt for \$15 by signing up in the Fellowship Hall or you can purchase one directly through Merricks. A percentage of every Romania t-shirt will help fund our overall cost. As you wear that t-shirt we are encouraging you to pray for our trip.



Due to requests we are offering a second more "generic" t-shirt. The new design is part of our second run of shirts which will be placed on **June 11th**. The new design will only be offered in two colors (Wild Plum and Crimson Red). The wild plum is limited to only T shirts, but the red will be available in T shirts, long sleeve shirts, crew neck sweatshirts, and hooded
