Currently, we have 12 young people going on this mission trip. (Burke Newman, Troy Soat, Andy Champalath, Dylan Runia, Francine Wiese, Ashton Reiter, Andrea Meyer, Britta Harberts and MaLeaha Doeden). We are hoping to raise approximately \$1000 per young adult going.

***The first fundraiser we are introducing is an envelope donation.**

Taped to the windows in the back of the sanctuary you will find envelopes numbered 1-99. You can take any one of those envelopes and place the dollar amount in the envelope that corresponds to the number on the outside of the envelope. For example, if you take envelope #7 then you would put \$7.00 in it. Please return these envelopes in the box provided. Taking an envelope higher than 50 will receive a free t-shirt.

***The second fundraiser we are doing is something we call a prayer t-shirt.** You can purchase a Romania t-shirt for \$15 by signing up in the Fellowship Hall or you can purchase one directly through Merricks.
