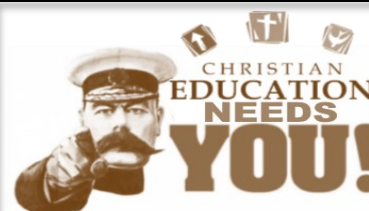
Attention Middle School Remnant students! (incoming 6th grade-8th grade)
