
E-Directory Instructions

- ⇒ If you would like to view our church e-directory go to: www.servantkeeper.com/directory/sibleyfrc. Once there you will need to put the church password in. The password is **SibleyFRC** This is not an app. If you would like quick access to this page, simply bookmark it to your phone's home screen or computer desktop.
- ⇒ After logging into the directory you will find a link toward the bottom of the page saying "Manage My Family Info". This is where you would go to make changes to your account profile, such as address, phone numbers, email address and even update your picture. In order to access the "Manage My Family Info" page you will need to receive an invitation from **no-reply@servantpc.com** in your email account. This email will be sent though the church office and not from servant keeper. If you would like to be able to access your family information please let the office know and we will get an invitation sent to you. Once you get your invitation, follow the link in the email to create your own username and password. This username and password is for your use only. It will be the information you will need to access the Member Portal. Here is an example of what the email will look like:
