Registration for Spring Cursillo is now open! Cursillo is a spiritual renewal program for people seeking to grow and deepen their faith in God. Cursillo is also intended to strengthen the local church through the development of Christian disciples and leaders. Cursillo begins on a Thursday evening and ends late Sunday afternoon. If participants are married, both spouses must attend. Men and women who are single, engaged, divorced or widowed may also attend. Those attending the Cursillo weekend hear a series of talks, worship together, participate in small-group discussions and participate in Holy Communion. Cursillo weekends are lay-led, with spiritual support and guidance from pastors. For the Spring Cursillo the Men's weekend is February 22-25 and the Women's weekend is Feb. 29-March 2, at Swan Lake, Viborg, SD. All those attending must have a sponsor. *Interested in learning more about* Cursillo?
