Gardeners, Bakers, Crafters... your items are needed. As usual, all the money collected from the table will be donated to a local food charity in Sibley.

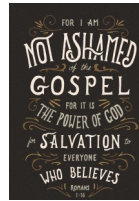
**A few teaching spots still remain open** for the Christian Education year. Please talk to Deb Kusters or check the information center to help out.
